Eight-Pointed Wreath Instructions

Materials: Eight (8) 3"x 6" papers

- 1. Fold papers in half the long way with the colored side to the outside and the open side up.
- With the open edge up, fold both corners down in the same direction so the side meets the folded bottom edge. The paper will look like a trapezoid.




3. With the open side up, fold each paper in half with the folded corners on the inside of the fold.



Remember to keep the **open edge of the folded paper up** before folding it in half

The corner folds are on the **inside** when the paper is ■ folded in half

 Flip pieces over so the open edge is on the bottom. Think of the pieces as little "ships" ready to sail.




half

Open edge is now on the bottom

The bottom of each little "ship" will have two slots in it.

5. Tuck the two points on one piece into the bottom two slots of another piece, with one point in each slot. Repeat with all pieces to create the wreath.
