## MAJOR REPAIRS COMPLETED IN 2018

Thanks to the generosity of local citizens and a grant from Oahe Electric's Operation Round Up program, extensive exterior repairs were completed at the Oahe Chapel in 2018. Those repairs included scraping, priming, and repainting the entire exterior, and rebuilding the front steps to allow for safer access into the historic chapel. You can see in the photos below what a difference these projects made.

The Oahe Chapel Preservation Society's Board of Directors would like to thank the many volunteers who made these projects possible. The painting project was coordinated by Don Zeller and included volunteers from the local chapter of Habitat for Humanity and the South Dakota Highway Patrol. The front steps were rebuilt by local contractor Ben Beierle, who volunteered his time for this project. We would also like to thank Oahe Electric for awarding us an Operation Round Up grant, which paid for the materials for the front steps project, and the Corps of Engineers, who hauled away the stone debris for us.
