
The Oahe Chapel Preservation Society was founded in 1984 to preserve and maintain the historic Oahe Chapel near Pierre, South Dakota. Funding for maintenance is provided through annual memberships with the Oahe Chapel Preservation Society, rental fees, donations, and fundraisers.

A Spotlight in History: The Founder's Father

The Oahe Mission was founded in 1874 and the Chapel building was constructed later in 1877. The mission was under the direction of Thomas Lawrence Riggs (1847—1940).

However, the Rigg's family roots go back even further in this present area of central South Dakota where the mission was founded. An account of this can be found in volume one of *History of South Dakota* (1904) by Doane Robinson and B.F. Bowen.

Dr. Steven Return Riggs (1812-1883) was in and around the central South Dakota (known then as the Dakota Territory) region as early as 1840. He held religious services with Tribes and Traders that occupied and lived in the vicinity of old Fort Pierre on the Missouri River.



Dr. Riggs was performing missionary work from his base in Lac-quiparle, Minnesota when it was decided he would travel to Fort Pierre. Dr. Riggs was under the American Board of Commissioners for Foreign Missions and received support from Congregational and Presbyterian Churches
