

Architectural Survey of Perkins and Harding Counties

The South Dakota State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) has contracted with cultural resource firm JMT, Inc. to survey historic architectural resources in Perkins and Harding Counties.

Beginning on Monday, August 7, 2023, the surveyors will conduct historical research and do fieldwork to take notes on and photographs of architectural resources that may be eligible for the National Register of Historic Places. All fieldwork will be conducted from the public right-of-way.

On Thursday, August 3rd, 2023, at 5:30pm (MT), South Dakota SHPO and JMT, Inc will be hosting a virtual informational meeting for those who would like to know more about the architectural survey for Perkins and Harding Counties and to have the ability to ask questions and suggest locations for survey or resources for historical research.
