

Archaeological Resource Management System (ARMS)

User License Agreement

The South Dakota archaeological archives consist of archaeological site records, survey records, reports, maps, GIS data, photographs, and artifact collection records. These are stored in paper records, in-house Microsoft Access databases, ESRI ArcMap shapefiles, and on an online database housed at <http://hawken.sdsmt.edu>. Collectively, the system is known as the Archaeological Resources Management System (ARMS). It is owned and operated by the Archaeological Research Center of the South Dakota State Historical Society. The information and data contained in the ARMS have been submitted to the Archaeological Research Center from various agencies, entities, and sources. The data and information compiled and stored in the database are owned by the source agency or entity that provided the data and information to the Archaeological Research Center.

The State of South Dakota, the South Dakota State Historical Society, and the Archaeological Research Center have not verified, confirmed or corroborated the accuracy, completeness, or reliability of the information or data submitted and placed into ARMS. The State of South Dakota, the South Dakota State Historical Society, and the Archeological Research Center are not responsible in any way for costs, damages, or any other liability resulting from use of the system.

The data and information compiled and stored in ARMS do not constitute public records and are protected under state and federal laws. While some portions of the data and information in ARMS are available to the public as a public service, the entirety of ARMS data is solely available to professional archaeologists doing research in South Dakota and to agencies requiring information on South Dakota archaeological sites within their jurisdiction.

The online ARMS database does not in its current form contain maps and miscellaneous documentation stored at the South Dakota Archaeological Research Center's archive. For that reason, it cannot be used in lieu of a formal records search to meet the requirements of Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 (as amended).

Use of the non-public portions of ARMS data constitutes a user license to access and use the data and information contained therein, and constitutes acceptance of the following conditions:

1. Users agree that the database will be used only for research and reference.
2. Users agree that they will credit the Archaeological Resource Management System (ARMS), Archaeological Research Center, South Dakota State Historical Society, and, if disclosed in the ARMS database, the owner or source of the specific data or information obtained, in any work, document, report, or presentation resulting from use of, or reflecting data or information contained in, ARMS.
3. Users agree to supply copies (both hardcopy and pdf) of any work, document, report or written presentation resulting from use of ARMS data to the Archaeological Research Center, South Dakota State Historical Society.
4. Users agree to maintain the confidentiality of the data or information obtained from ARMS data. Users further agree that they will not allow third parties to use their license and will not make copies of information or data in ARMS for third parties.
5. Users agree that site specific location information and data obtained from ARMS will not be disclosed, stated, reported, or otherwise disseminated in any work, document, report or presentation intended for dissemination to the general public or a general audience.

6. Users understand that it is their responsibility to verify the accuracy, completeness, or reliability of any information or data derived or obtained from the use of ARMS data. Users understand that the information and data submitted and placed in ARMS has not been verified, confirmed, or corroborated by the State of South Dakota, the South Dakota State Historical Society, or the Archeological Research Center.
7. Users agree that they release and hold the State of South Dakota, the South Dakota State Historical Society, and the Archeological Research Center, and their officers, agents and employees, harmless from and against any and all actions, suits, damages, liability or other proceedings that may arise as the result of use of ARMS data.
8. Users understand and agree that any violation of these conditions will result in the immediate cancellation and termination of their user license and access to ARMS.

Users are granted access to ARMS data for the purposes of professional archaeological or historical research and for cultural resource management under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act. This license is good for one year upon notification by the Archeological Research Center that the agreement has been accepted. Fees for use of ARMS data are set in Administrative Rules of South Dakota 24:52:05:02.
