Scope and Content:

The collection consists of information relating to the Anti-Gambling/Video Lottery campaigns, the South Dakota Governor's Cup, and other South Dakota chess activities.

The Anti-Gambling/Video Lottery campaign materials date from 1994 to 2006. The majority of the collection includes news clippings, letters to the editor, and editorials. The collection covers a wide variety of topics on gambling and political activities relating to gambling in South Dakota.

Also included in this collection is South Dakota Governor's Cup information with scrapbooks, photographs, news clippings, newsletter, and various articles on playing chess and chess players in South Dakota. One high point for chess in South Dakota was the National High School Chess Championship held in Sioux Falls in 1999.

The book "The Luck Business" by Robert Goodman was added to the State Archives Library and t-shirts and a chess set were transferred to the museum of the State Historical Society for their consideration.
