Artists of all skill levels and any media are invited to participate in *The Art of Place* and create artwork inspired by historic places around Pierre & Fort Pierre. Join us on **May 18** for a Kickoff Day of workshops and tours. At our public exhibit at Oahe Days, **June 22-23**, your artwork will draw attention to the special places in our community.

At the May 18th Kickoff Day, art workshops and historical tours will be offered at the Capital Area Senior Center (401 W. Pleasant Drive) and throughout Pierre and Fort Pierre. Use the day to work on your artwork out in the community, and stop by the Senior Center anytime from 8:30am to 5:00pm for refreshments or a creative break. Continue working individually over the following weeks and finished pieces will be shown at the public exhibit at Oahe Days in Pierre. Artwork up to 16x24 inches may be contributed to the exhibit. (More than one piece is acceptable if all submitted pieces fit into one 16x24 space). *The Art of Place* is an awareness-building event, so artwork will not be for sale. However, artists may post business cards near their work. Artwork must be brought to *The Art of Place* booth at the Oahe Days festival before 10:00am on Saturday, June 22 to be exhibited in the display. Overnight, artists may take their pieces home on Saturday and bring the same or additional pieces on Sunday morning. All artists must collect their work at the booth at 4:00pm on Sunday, June 23. If you would be willing to help staff the booth for a period of time on Saturday or Sunday, please check the box on the accompanying registration form and we will contact you in early June.

A full schedule for the Kickoff Day and final details on exhibit set-up and take-down will be sent out to registered participants.
