    - 2. This is the afternoon section. These groups were with me for one class each since the school was departmentalized. Note the albinos – a girl and a boy. AG Hood, front row, extreme left. Appeared to be white but was sent to segregated school so he must have had mixed blood. Boy on knees at extreme right of row two, front had brilliantly red hair and freckles – could have easily passed in white school. Mission had three way segregation: white, Latin-American, and a small, one-room Negro school. Taxes on the white population paid for all schools.
