

## Interior Department Territorial Papers

Congress delegated supervision of the Territories to the Secretary of State until 1873 when they were assigned to the Department of the Interior. The papers described below are chiefly original letters from the Territorial Governors and secretaries to the President or to the Secretaries of State or the Interior; journals of executive proceedings in Territories; acts of Territorial legislatures; and letters and documents predating the establishment of a Territory. These papers are from the Records of the Office of the Secretary of the Interior.
