Fort Peck (Montana)

Fort Peck was a fortified trading post located on the north side of the Missouri River about one mile upriver from the present-day Fort Peck Dam. The trading post was built in 1867 and operated into the 1870s. It also served as the headquarters of the Fort Peck/Milk River Indian Agency through 1879. The original site is now underwater due to erosion and the construction of Fort Peck Dam.
