Fort St. Charles (Minnesota)

Fort St. Charles was a French trading post located on Magnuson's Island on the Northwest Angle of present-day Minnesota. It was established in the summer of 1732 by Pierre Gaultier de Varenne, Sieur de La Verendrye. The fort was abandoned in 1749.
