## Historic Preservation Fund

### Selected Expenditures\*, FY 2006-2015

*Established in 1977, the Historic Preservation Fund (HPF) is the Federal funding source of the preservation awards to the States, Tribes, local governments, and non-profits. Authorized at \$150 million per year, the funding is provided by Outer Continental Shelf oil lease revenues, not tax dollars. The HPF uses revenues of a non-renewable resource to benefit the preservation of other irreplaceable resources.*
